EOT Project: Integrating Your Knowledge

Using the Web, Word, and HTML together

Due: 5th January 2004, in your LAST class

Project Task

Your job is to evaluate and compare 3 Web Sites on a topic of your choosing. You must do the following:

- 1. Decide which topic you are going to search the web about and tell your lecturer.
- 2. Search the web find and evaluate and rank 3 websites about your given topic.
- 3. Present your evaluations in a report written in MS Word
- 4. **Summarise** your findings in an html document, with links to your chosen web sites, photographs of your chosen topic and a link to your word document

<u>Step One – Choose your topic</u>

Tell your lecturer which topic you have chose BEFORE you start your Internet searching.

Important: your topic is subject to your lecturer's approval. He will **also check** it has not been chosen by another class member.

Step Two – Searching the Internet:

Find and evaluate 3 web sites on your chosen topic. You should use the 'Worksheet for **Evaluating Web Sites**' that is attached to help with your evaluation of each web site and to also help you rank them from '**Helpful**' (the two web sites you would most likely use for your research, with reasons given) to '**Least helpful**' (the one web site you would reject and not use in your research, with reasons given).

For each evaluation, you must state your reasons, <u>based on the criteria</u> given in your classes on what makes a good web site and also the criteria in the '**Worksheet for Evaluating Web Sites**'.

<u>Step Three – Present your evaluations in a report in MS Word:</u>

Type up your evaluations in the form of a report in MS Word. Your Word document should include:

- A header and a footer
- A title that has a border and is shaded
- A table (*that, for example, compares the three web sites*)
- An indented paragraph
- A bulleted list

Put this document **into a folder** in your Home Folder, labeled '**EOT Project** *your name your number your class*'.

Step Four – Summarise your findings in an html document:

Lastly, make a summary of your evaluations and put it into an html document. This document should include the tags you have been taught. It should include photographs connected with your chosen topic, links to the evaluated websites and another link to the word report. This html document and photographs should also be **put into your project folder**.

Summary: What is Required

On your last day of class – **January 5th 2004** – make sure your project folder is in **your teacher's** folder in Work Finished, in a folder that is labeled <u>'*Class name* EOT Projects'</u>.

- Your **project folder** must include:
 - The MS Word document with your evaluations of the websites, and
 - o An html document with a summary of your findings, as well as
 - Photographs included in your html file.

Any Projects that are turned in late will lose 10% for every day they are late.
